# Important Information

- 1) Parade date: Saturday Dec. 10, 2005.
- 2) All boats must report to the staging area by 5:30 pm or they will lose their place in the parade.
- 3) Parade will start at 6:30 pm sharp.
- 4) Parade channel is VHF82. If you need to talk to another boat, hail on 82 and switch channels.
- 5) Boats must adhere to the instructions of the parade staff (Coast Guard Auxiliary).
- 6) All captains must attend the captains meeting on Tuesday Dec. 6, 2005 at the Dewar's 12 Lounge at the American Airlines Arena.
- 7) This form is an application. The Parade reserves the right to grant/deny any application.
- 8) All boats must submit valid insurance along with this application.

## Decorating Guidelines & Tips

The parade will be seen by thousands of spectators and hundreds of thousands of television viewers. Put you best foot forward!

- This year's theme is "Holidays Around the World"
- Boats adhering to the theme will be given television time preference.
- The parade lasts approximately 3 hours. The television special is only half an hour. Ensure your time in the spotlight with your decorations and creativity.
- The more lights the better. Check our website for wattage and electrical concerns.
- Use sound to enhance your presentation. Face speaker towards the shoreline.
- The television cameras will be on BOTH SIDES of your boat. Make sure to decorate accordingly.
- Use props, costumes, characters, and spotlights to enrich your display.
